

The sketch in the name banner at the top was done in 2005 by member Terry Lege, son of member Ray Lege.

The scene is a depiction of an old farmstead in the Coulee Kinney area, four miles north of Abbeville, LA where Terry's grandparents, Percy Lege and Zoie LeBlanc Lege lived from around 1940 to 1962 when they moved to the city limits of Abbeville.

Percy, or "Kaplan" as he was known to many, was a tenant rice farmer at this site while his family lived there and even after the move to the city limits, for a total of about 40 years.

The sketch was done as a labor of love to the memory of Terry's grandfather who passed away in December 1998, one week before his 86th birthday. His widow, Zoie, along with his three children, seven of his grandchildren and three of his great-grandchildren, are all members of the Richelieu Leger Family Association
